



WHERE CAN YOU DISPOSE OF YOUR WASTE?

Waste separation is important to the municipality of Bergen. This is because everything except residual waste can be used again. To promote waste separation, we work with variable expenses: we pay per time that we throw away residual waste in the underground container. This is why we ask you to separate food and garden waste, PMD (plastic, tin/metal and drink cartons), paper waste and cardboard, glass, and nappies.

What do you dispose of where?



FOOD AND GARDEN WASTE GOES IN THE FOOD AND GARDEN WASTE BIN

Food waste, leftover fish and meat, coffee and coffee filters, tea bags.

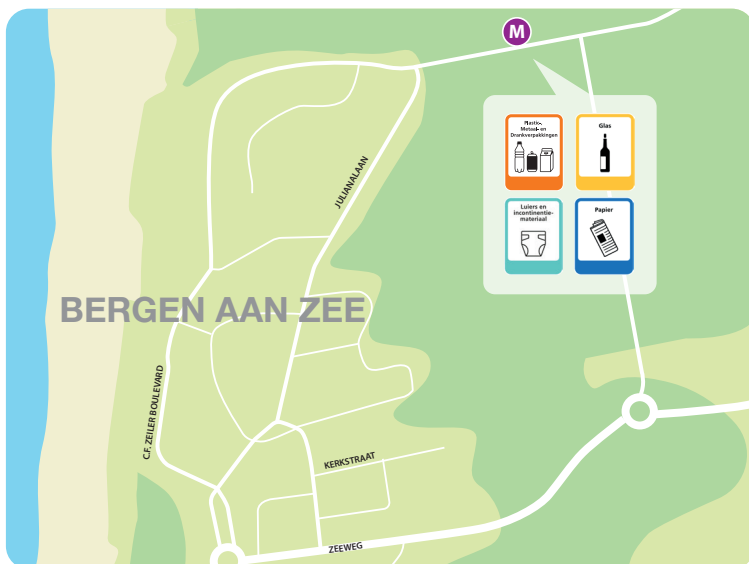


PMD (PLASTIC, TIN/METAL AND DRINK CARTONS)

Includes drink cartons, tin cans, tubes, aluminium foil.

You can get rid of your PMD waste with your other residual waste in the underground residual waste container. You can also separate your PMD waste yourself.

Where can you take your waste?

pmd | glass | paper waste | nappies*

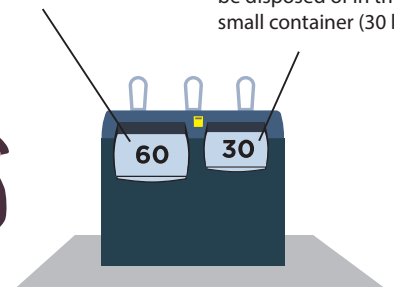


Everything that is left over after separation, is your residual waste. Your bags with residual waste go in the underground container at the following address. Bring your waste disposal card!



You can dispose of large bags in the large container (60 l.)

And small bags can be disposed of in the small container (30 l.)
